

WEST HIGHLANDS DOG PARK RULES

PARK RULES

- **Please report illegal activity to 911**
- Dog Park access and use is permitted dawn to dusk
- Only West Highlands residents' dogs are allowed
- All users of the off-leash area shall assume all risk and liability associated with use of the Dog Park. Use at your own risk. The West Highlands Homeowners Association and Management are not responsible for any damage or injury to person or pet
- The Dog Park is designated for canine activities only. It is not intended for any other purpose
- The only food of any kind allowed is bite-size dog treats
- The Dog Park may be closed in times of bad weather or for maintenance
- Owner/handler must immediately clean up after dogs and properly. (This is the required by law.)

DOG RULES

- All dogs must be properly licensed, healthy, and be current on vaccinations
- All dogs must wear a collar and ID tag
- The following dogs are not allowed in the park:
 - Vicious, dangerous, or aggressive dogs
 - Sick dogs
 - Dogs in heat
 - Puppies under six months of age
- Any dog that barks continually must be removed or muzzled by her/his owner/handler
- Dogs must be kept on a leash until inside the double-gated entry area. Enter the first gate with the leash on and remove it prior to entering the second gate. Do the reverse when leaving
- No more than two dogs per owner/handler shall be allowed in the area at one time
- No dogs are permitted to enter with pronged or spike collars or collars that may injure other dogs
- No animals other than dogs may be brought into the dog park
- Dogs are not permitted on benches

OWNER/HANDLER RULES

- Owner/handler is legally and financially responsible for the actions of their dog
- Each dog must be kept within sight of her/his owner/handler and under voice control. Dogs must not be left unattended. At all times the owner/handler must have a leash in their possession
- Owners/handlers have responsibility for watching their dog's behavior. If a dog displays aggressive behavior or fights, the owner/handler shall be responsible for immediately controlling or removing the dog from the dog park. This includes excessive humping
- If a bite occurs, you must exchange your name and phone number with the other owner/handler
- Owners/handlers must immediately clean up and properly dispose of waste left by their dogs and must cover any holes dug by their dogs
- Owners/handlers must place their dog in the appropriate enclosure based on weight of dog: Small dogs (<30 lbs) or Large dogs (30+ lbs)
- No children under the age of 12 are allowed in the area without close adult supervision
- Parents should refrain from bringing toddlers and small children to the dog park. At no time will children be allowed to run with or chase after dogs in the park

Owners/handlers who fail to abide by West Highlands Dog Park rules and community rules and regulations will be subjected to loss of Dog Park privileges. Fines or other sanctions may be imposed.
